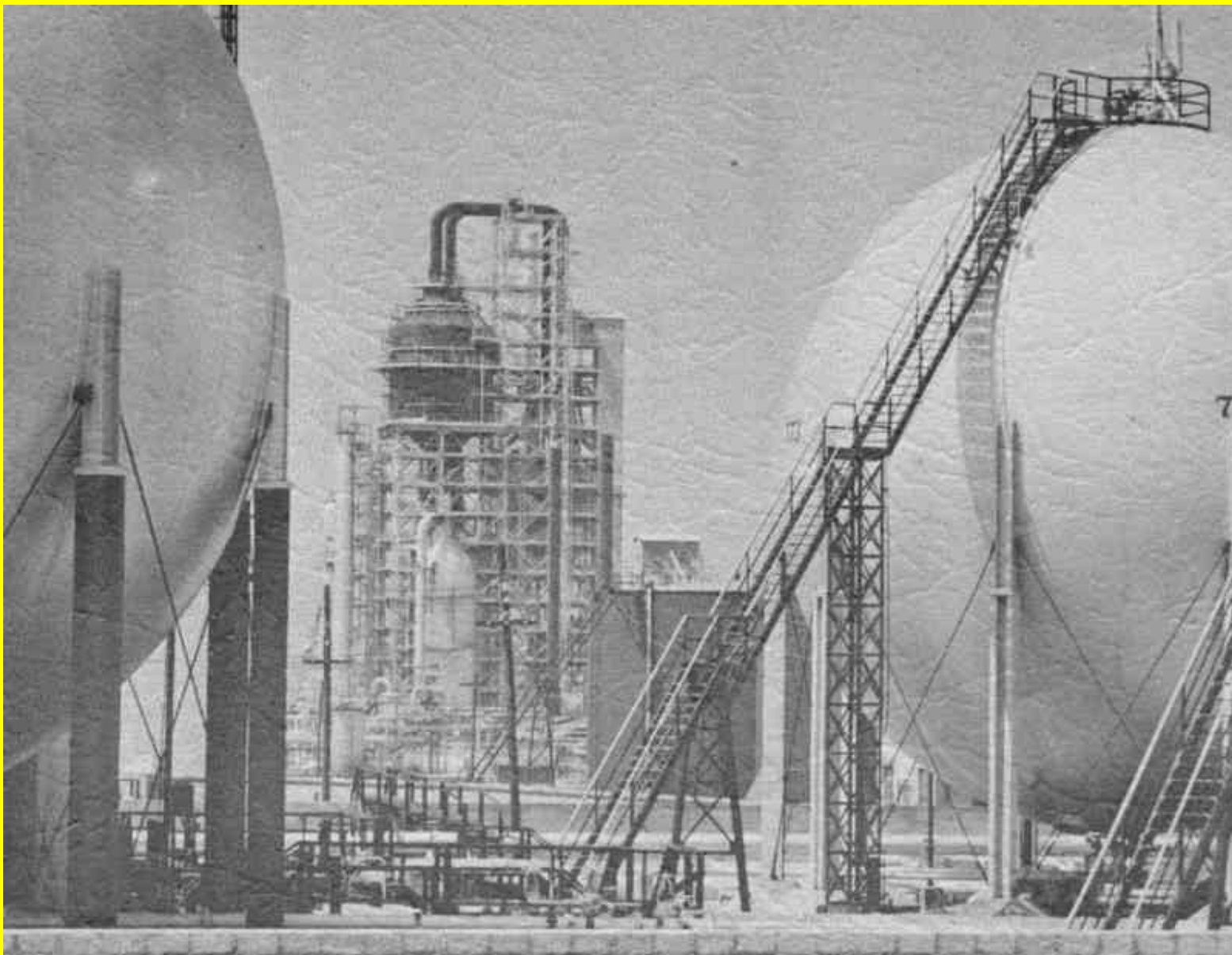

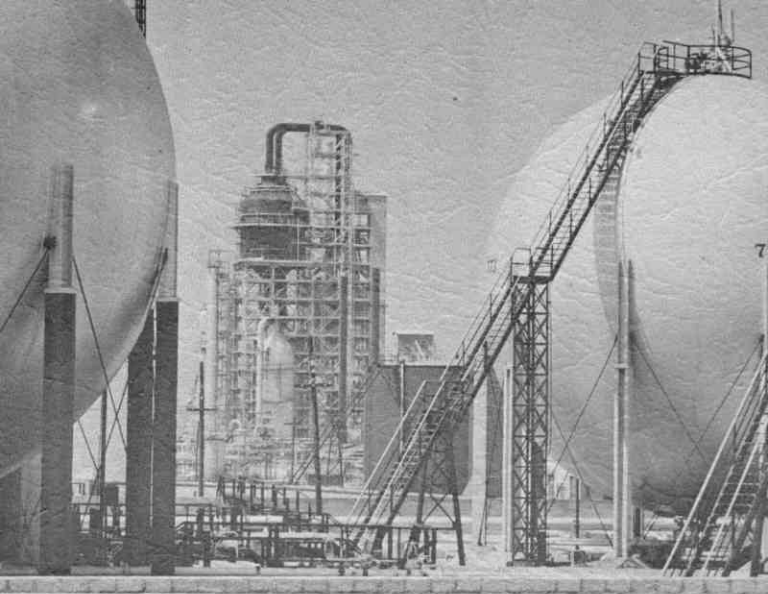

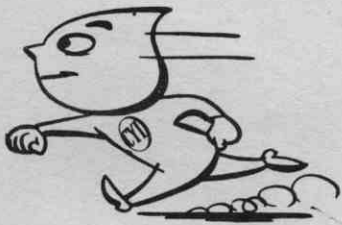

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE TELEPHONE

DIAL TONE - THIS IS A STEADY BUZZ AND IS HEARD AFTER LIFTING THE HANDSET FROM ITS CRADLE AND BEFORE DIALING. IT INDICATES THAT THE PHONE IS READY FOR USE. WHEN NO TONE IS HEARD UPON LIFTING THE HANDSET, EITHER THE OTHER PARTY IS USING THE LINE, OR THE SECTION OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM WHICH CONTROLS YOUR OWN PHONE IS BUSY. HANG UP AND TRY AGAIN IN A FEW SECONDS.

BUSY SIGNAL - THIS IS AN INTERMITTENT BUZZ. WHEN HEARD AFTER DIALING IT MEANS THAT THE NUMBER BEING CALLED IS BUSY. HANG UP AND TRY AGAIN IN A SHORT TIME.

DIALING - PLACE FINGER (NOT PENCIL OR OTHER IMPLEMENTS) IN THE OPENING OVER THE FIRST DIGIT OF THE NUMBER BEING CALLED, TURN DIAL TO FINGER STOP AND THEN RELEASE; WAIT UNTIL DIAL TONE STOPS, THEN DIAL THE OTHER DIGITS OF THE NUMBER BEING CALLED IN THE SAME MANNER.

CAUTION - DO NOT FORCE THE DIAL TO ITS RESTING POSITION, AS THE SATISFACTORY OPERATION OF THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM DEPENDS UPON THE CORRECT SPEED OF THE DIAL WHILE RETURNING TO THE REST POSITION.

END OF CONVERSATION - AT THE END OF A CONVERSATION RETURN HANDSET TO ITS CRADLE. IF THE HANDSET IS NOT PROPERLY REPLACED, BOTH YOUR PHONE AND THE OTHER SUBSCRIBER'S PHONE WILL REMAIN OUT OF SERVICE.

WRONG NUMBERS - IF YOUR PHONE REPEATEDLY DIALS WRONG NUMBERS AND YOU HAVE FOLLOWED CORRECTLY THE INSTRUCTIONS ON DIALING, YOUR PHONE PROBABLY REQUIRES ADJUSTMENT. SEE INSTRUCTIONS FOR REQUESTING REPAIRS TO YOUR PHONE. ## OVERSEAS TELEPHONE CALLS

### OUTGOING CALLS

TELEPHONE THE CABLE CLERK (NO. 3400) AND REQUEST THE DESIRED RADIO-TELEPHONE CONNECTION. GIVE THE CABLE CLERK YOUR NAME, PAYROLL NUMBER, AND TELEPHONE NUMBER.

THE CABLE CLERK WILL MAKE THE NECESSARY ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE RADIO STATION. WHEN THE RADIO CHANNEL IS AVAILABLE, YOU WILL BE CALLED BY THE GOVERNMENT RADIO STATION, AND THE CONNECTION WITH THE CALLED PARTY OVERSEAS WILL BE COMPLETED.

A CANCELLATION FEE OF FLG. 1.50 PER CALL WILL BE MADE ON TRANSATLANTIC CALLS FOR WHICH ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN COMPLETED BUT, THROUGH NO FAULT OF THE SERVICE, THE CALL IS NOT CONSUMMATED.

### INCOMING CALLS

THE RADIO STATION WILL INFORM THE CABLE CLERK THAT A DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL IS BEING CALLED.

THE CABLE CLERK WILL LOCATE THE CALLED PARTY AND REQUEST HIM TO STAND BY AT ANY SELECTED TELEPHONE.

THE CABLE CLERK WILL THEN ADVISE THE RADIO STATION AT WHAT TELEPHONE NUMBER THE DESIGNATED INDIVIDUAL MAY BE REACHED.

THE RADIO STATION WILL CALL THE SELECTED TELEPHONE NUMBER AND COMPLETE THE OVERSEAS COMMUNICATION.

THE GOVERNMENT WILL BILL THE COMPANY FOR PERSONAL CALLS OF EMPLOYEES AND COLLECTION WILL BE MADE, AS AT PRESENT, BY PAYROLL DEDUCTION. CALLS ORIGINATING IN THE UNITED STATES MAY BE ACCEPTED BY PERSONS IN THE NETHERLANDS ANTILLES ON A COLLECT-BASIS. THE CALLED PARTY IN THE NETHERLANDS ANTILLES MUST, PRIOR TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE CALL, DECLARE HIS WILLINGNESS TO PAY THE CHARGES THEREOF. IN THE EVENT THE CHARGES ARE REVERSED, THE CALLED PARTY WILL BE BILLED THROUGH THE COMPANY IN THE SAME MANNER AS FOR OUTGOING CALLS.

CASH PAYMENT MAY BE MADE BY OBTAINING FORM AC-145 FROM THE CLERK ON DUTY IN THE CABLE OFFICE, DEPOSITING THE CASH AT THE CASHIER'S OFFICE, GENERAL OFFICE BUILDING AND RETURNING THE RECEIPTED FORM TO THE CABLE CLERK.

SHOULD THE ORIGINATORS OF OVERSEAS TELEPHONE CALLS, OR PERSONS ACCEPTING "COLLECT" OVERSEAS CALLS, FEEL THAT A CLAIM FOR REDUCTION OR CANCELLATION OF CHARGES IS WARRANTED, DUE TO POOR CONNECTION OR INABILITY TO HEAR OR BE HEARD, THEY SHOULD FILE CLAIM IMMEDIATELY WITH THE GOVERNMENT OPERATOR BY DIALING 1910 OR 1911 ON THE OUTSIDE EXCHANGE.

THE OVERSEAS TELEPHONE BOOTH IN THE GENERAL OFFICE BUILDING WILL BE MAINTAINED FOR THE USE OF TRANSIENTS AND EMPLOYEES WHO DO NOT HAVE A RESIDENCE TELEPHONE, OR FOR BUSINESS CALLS WHERE MORE CONVENIENT.
