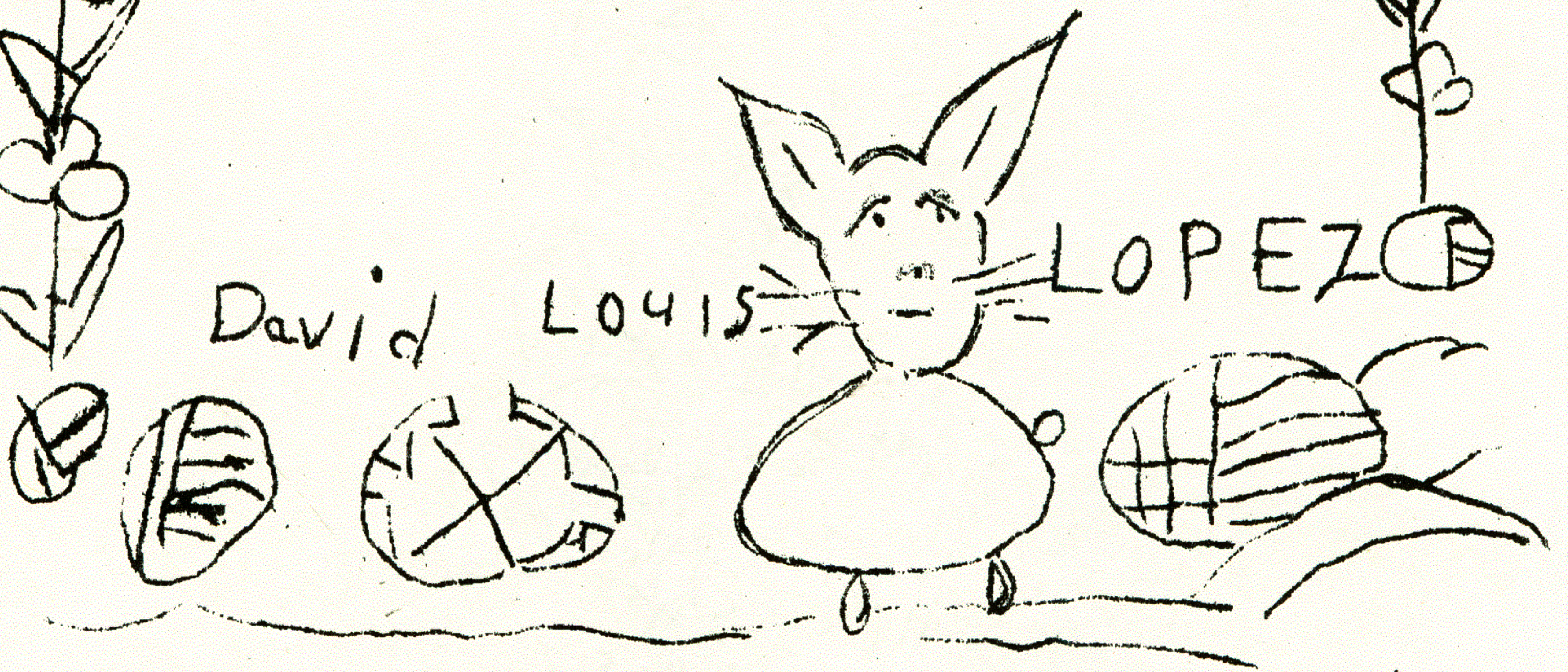

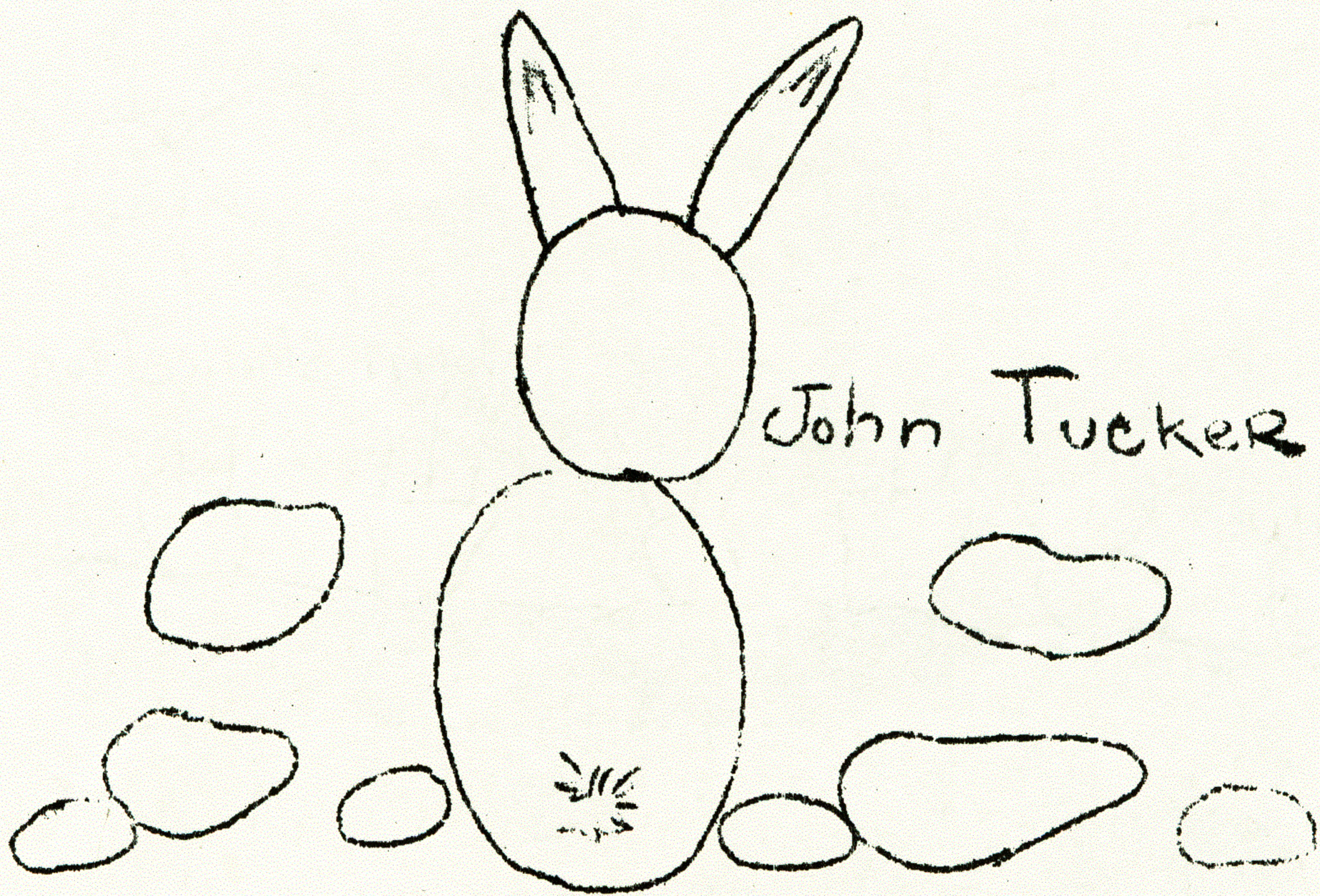

Easter Bunny

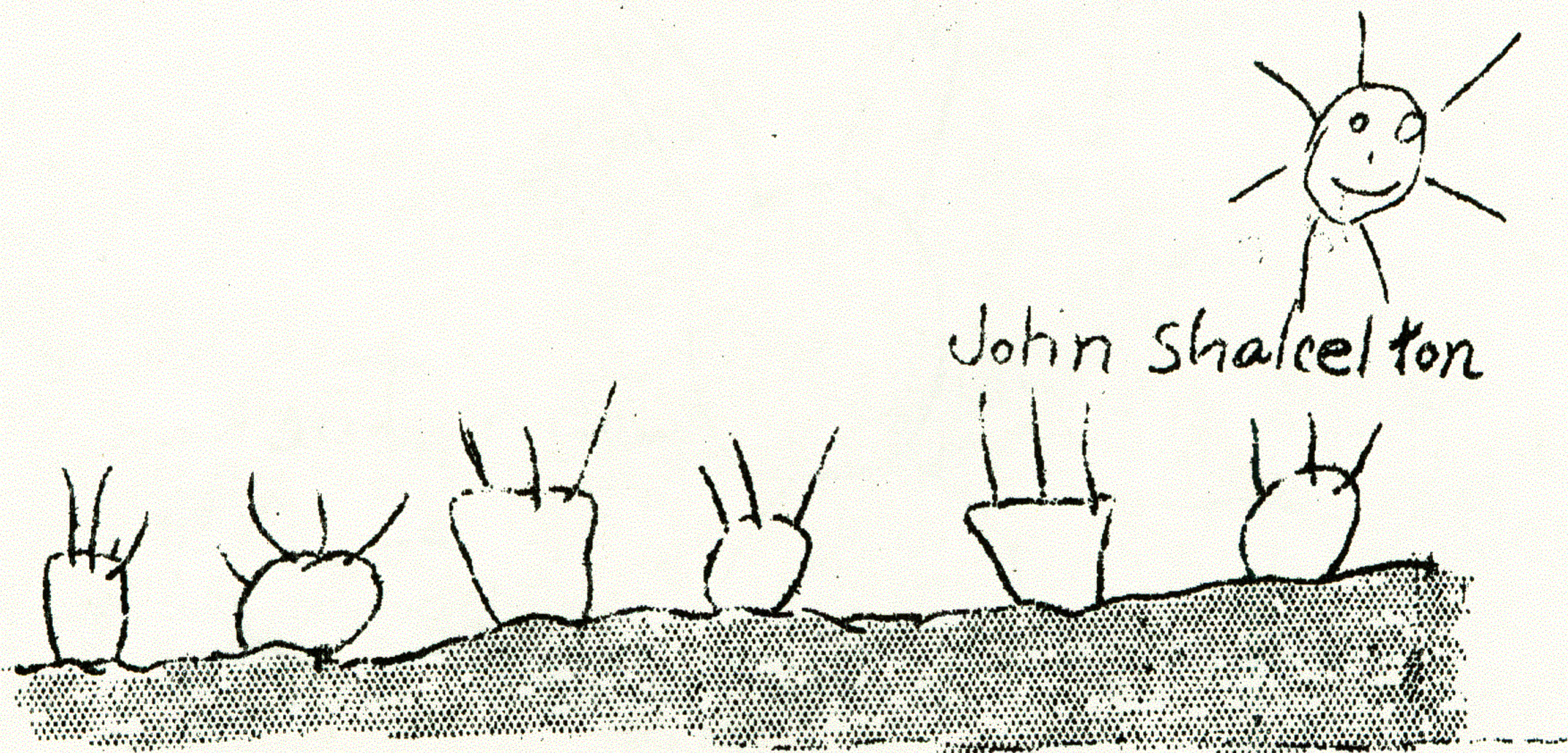
